

## TRANSPORTATION OF POWER-SONIC BATTERIES BY AIR NOT RESTRICTED, AS PER SPECIAL PROVISION A67

After consultation with the **DANGEROUS GOODS OFFICE** of the **CIVIL AVIATION AUTHORITY**, **POWER-SONIC BATTERIES** when fitted as an integral part of **ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT** can be transported according to PI 872 and according to A67 as not restricted (IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations). The batteries must be securely fastened in the battery holder of the equipment and protected in such a manner as to prevent damage and short circuit.

The **CLASSIFICATION** for this type of battery is **UN2800 BATTERIES WET, NON-SPILLABLE**, electric storage.

**POWER-SONIC BATTERIES COMPLY IN FULL WITH SPECIAL PROVISION A67** which applies to this classification and states that:

**NON-SPILLABLE BATTERIES** are **not RESTRICTED** if at a Temperature of 55°C (130°F) the electrolyte will not flow from a ruptured or cracked case and there is no free liquid to flow, and if, when packed for transport, the terminals are protected from short circuit.
